OUTBREAK OF AFRICAN HORSE SICKNESS WITHIN THE AFRICAN HORSE SICKNESS SURVEILLANCE ZONE OF THE WESTERN CAPE PROVINCE

The Department of Agriculture of the Western Cape Province is investigating a possible outbreak of African horse sickness near the town of Mamre in the African horse sickness surveillance zone of the Western Cape Province.

An immediate ban has been placed on all movement of equidae in the area. Details of quarantine measures will be released shortly.

All owners of horses, donkeys and mules are requested to report any suspicious cases of African horse sickness to their nearest state veterinarian.
